MIGRATION FROM RAJASTHAN







Rajasthan Pravasi Sharmik Kalyan Prakosth

The Rajasthan Pravasi Sharmik Kalyan Prakosth (RPSKP), under the Rajasthan Skill and Livelihoods Development Corporation (RSLDC), focuses on the welfare of Rajasthan-origin emigrants. It promotes safe migration, addresses grievances via the MADAD and PBSK (Pravasi Bharatiya Sahayata Kendra) portals, ensures crisis support, and facilitates the repatriation and transportation of mortal remains through Indian missions.
